

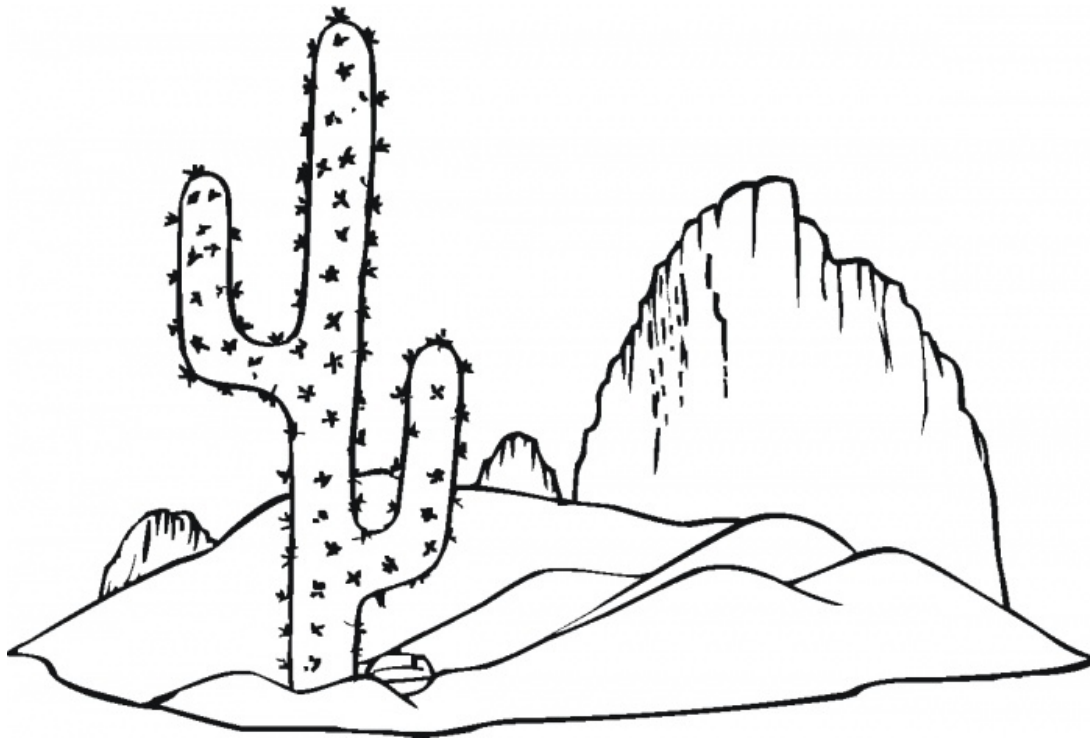

Note: Phoenix Sky Harbor airport is about 10 minutes away from downtown Tempe/the ASU Campus. If you are staying at the Graduate Hotel (7C on map, 225 E.
